Following the Government updates this week and through our ongoing consultation with the Department for Culture, Media and Sport and Sport England, we are delighted to confirm that badminton can continue, as planned, with our previously approved progression to Phase 3.

We have worked with Government and lobbied for the continued evolution of our guidance in direct response to your feedback about what would help more of you to return to play. Therefore, Phase 3 includes two key developments:

- 1. The return of match league play is now possible
- 2. Increasing coach to player ratios

Both of these will hopefully help even more clubs, coaches and players get back on court. We continue to work on new and innovative formats which will allow players to compete in tournaments.

The move to Phase 3 has been possible because players, clubs and coaches have returned safely and in line with our guidance. All of your hard work in making the return to play possible means that we can now amend our guidance to allow for more formats to be played.

Although the move to Phase 3 is welcome, we very much recognise the challenges that many of you face in trying to find a venue in which you can play and in ensuring that your sessions are financially viable. Our hardship fund has allocated thousands of pounds to affiliated clubs and registered coaches and it will reopen shortly to continue to support you to get back on court. We continue to do everything we can to get more venues open and to help clubs find alternatives.
