Simplified ANNOUNCEMENT & ALERT Summary

When to ANNOUNCE? There are some Information bids and Artificial bids which are now announced. These are generally the Strength of an Opening 1NT, Stayman and Transfers and some Jump bids.

When to ALERT? If partner bids something else which is not Natural or has a different meaning to that expected. Use the ALERT CARD for these bids which are not Natural.

Please be tolerant if opponents alert when they should announce or announce when they shouldn't.
